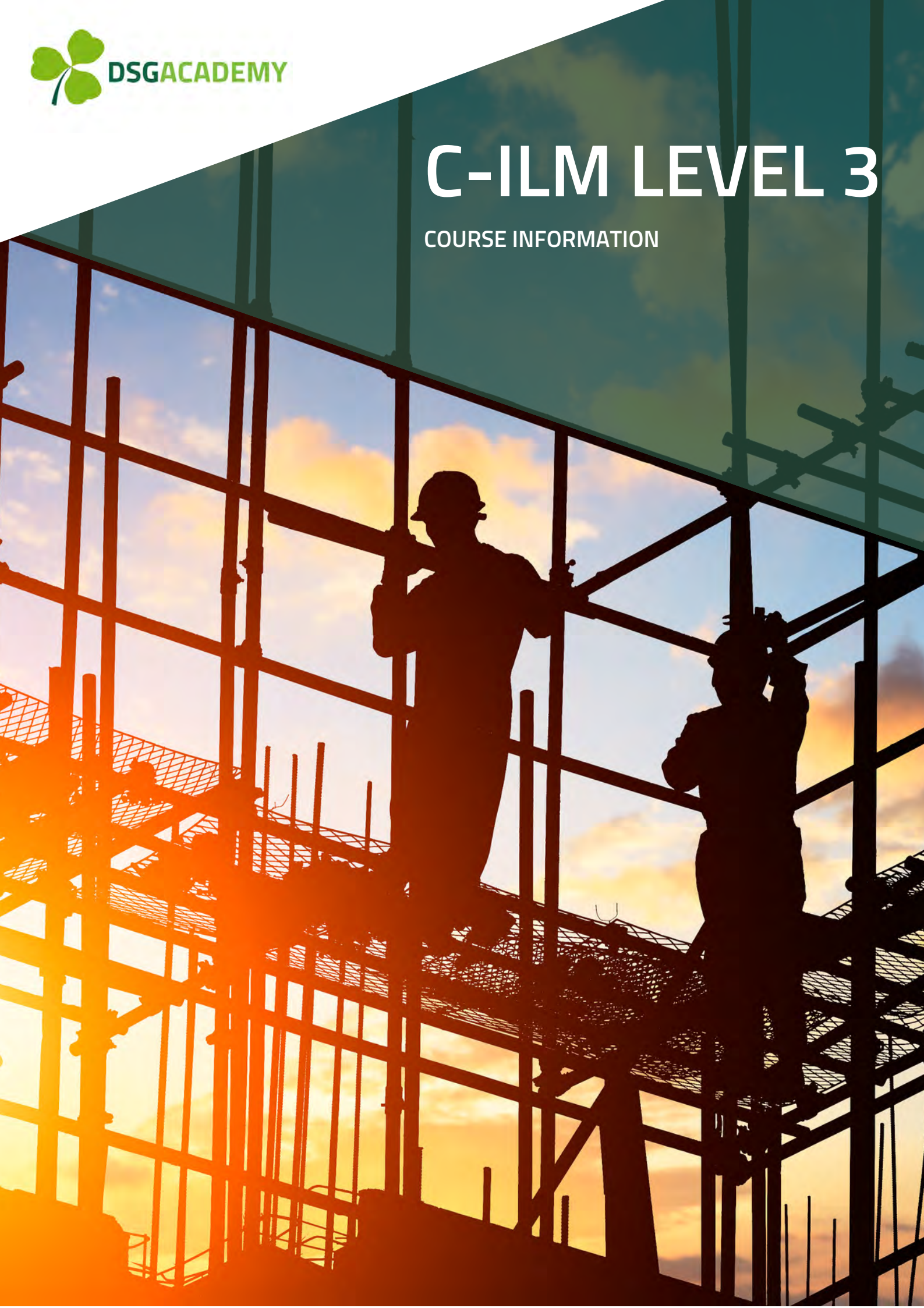

COURSE INFORMATION

The C-ILM Level 3 Certificate is a nationally recognised leadership qualification.

The course will teach you the basic leadership and management skills required to help you better lead your teams.

You will identify the strengths and weaknesses of both you and your company and develop action plans and tools to improve performance, avoid mistakes of the trade and, learn what makes a good manager.

The Level 3 Leadership and Management for the Construction and Built Environment Sector is a non-technical qualification and certificate.

It is suitable for practicing team leaders and supervisors as well as those looking for promotion or for those identified through talent management programs.

It provides the opportunity to formally develop and consolidate skills through an industry benchmarked qualification.

The construction units aim to develop core leadership and management, coaching, influencing, motivational, quality, productivity and people skills.

These skills are essential to drive forward projects and programs of work - in line with the sector skills needs of major employers, contractors and projects.

The C-ILM Level 3 in Leadership and Management part 1 and 2 award and certificate qualification, is a qualification for anyone with management responsibilities but has no formal qualification.

The award is particularly suited to up and coming or practising team leaders/managers seeking to move up to the next level of management, and current managers who need to lead people through organisational change, budget cuts or other pressures.

These are non-technical qualifications that are aimed at up and coming or current team leaders from supervisors, engineers, and agents to senior managers and directors looking to gain a thorough understanding of leadership and management principles to effectively lead, supervise and safely manage staff.

Anyone in a management or supervisory position within the construction and built environment sector will benefit from the C-ILM level in construction 3 certificate or award course.

You will need to be in a construction related workplace to complete the the course assignments.





THE C-ILM LEVEL 3 QUALIFICATION

Candidates who complete all five modules and corresponding assessments, will receive a C-ILM Level 3 Certificate in Leadership and Management Practice for the Construction and Built Environment Sector.

Successful candidates will be able to obtain their white CSCS card for academically qualified persons.

The course is taught through remote, online learning using Microsoft Teams or Zoom or a suitable online platform.

All training can be delivered via live, virtual sessions providing a great solution for learners who may be spread across different locations.

This flexible learning removes and minimises the need to travel for those who may live in different locations.

Learners also have the ability to rebook their training workshops if work commitments take priority.

COURSE MODULES

LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT PRACTICE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND BUILT ENVIRONMENT SECTOR

This module will help you to develop your management skills specifically in the construction sector. You will learn techniques that can be used within other industries as well as techniques which will be specific to the built environment sector.

DELIVERY OF SITE OPERATIONS AND LOGISTICS

One of the main duties for a manager within the construction industry is being able to understand logistics and use them effectively to ensure the smooth running of site operations. This module will teach you how to deal with logistics on site and how to deliver to specified site operations.

UNDERSTANDING COMMERCIAL AWARENESS

This module will help a manager within any sector. Every manager will need to be commercially aware and know when a project is not commercially viable, when you might need to bring in more equipment and what to charge or pay for it.

HANDLING DIFFICULT SITUATIONS

A difficult situation can be anything from a disgruntled employee to problems with equipment on site. This module will teach you how to not only deal with the situation but also how to solve it.

ACHIEVING PERFORMANCE THROUGH PEOPLE

As a manager your best resources are the people that work for you. You will need to attract and develop the best employees to help you to achieve your goals. This module will teach you how to achieve performance using the employees who work for you.

COURSE COST
